

My youngest child attends St. Paul High School (SPHS) and will graduate in 2023. I am also a proud alum of the school having graduated in 1983. My other three children also graduated from SPHS in 2005, 2016 and 2018. I presently serve on the School's Advisory Council and I head up the parent association at the school. SPHS is located immediately adjacent to the Superfund site that CenterPoint is actively redeveloping at 9648 Santa Fe Springs Drive, Santa Fe Springs CA. I wanted to write in support of CenterPoint's proposed project and ask that you help their team in moving the redevelopment project forward. Currently, the site is an open field which results in a potentially unsafe situation for us due to homeless encampments, theft, and vandalism in and around the school and neighborhood. The CenterPoint team has been in active communication with the school administration and parents regarding their proposed project and the steps they plan on taking to ensure the good health and safety of the students and faculty during construction and beyond. I strongly believe that a completed building next door would address the blight of this nearly five decades old vacant site and will ultimately be a tremendous benefit to the school and a productive asset for the surrounding community.

Furthermore, as a gesture of good faith, CenterPoint has offered to repave the school parking lot and make improvements to the school athletic fields adjacent to their property, which has been negatively impacted from years neglect by the previous owners of the project site. In summary, I support CenterPoint's project and kindly request CalEPA to complete the project review and approval process in a timely manner.
